Each year, the Women's Guild in the UN Headquarters supports over 100 children's projects across 68 countries.

The Guild channels funds to projects providing shelter, food, education and health care to impoverished, orphaned, disabled, neglected children with all kinds of needs. Our international membership provides the personal link necessary to make assistance available to communities with limited ability to obtain outside support.

Members of the Guild work as volunteers to raise funds for all these projects. With minimal overhead expenses thanks to the support of the UN, the maximum possible funds go to assisting children in need.

The Guild's main source of income is the UNWG shop, which is located in the Visitor Centre of the United Nations. The shop also services mail and online order purchases.

Additional funds are raised through various fundraising efforts including annual bazaars, concerts, art exhibition and other cultural events.

Since it was founded in 1948, the Guild in New York has grown to four Groups: Manhattan, Queens, Secretariat and Westchester, overseen by a Coordination Board. All Groups meet twice a month. Affiliate Groups such as UNWG Geneva, India, Jamaica, Peru, Rome and Vienna are independent but connected in our mutual aim to improve the future of children in vulnerable situations.
